for the use of IMIPRAMINE

IMIPRAMINE is an antidepressant medication approved by FDA for the treatment of:

- Depression
- Chronic Pain Syndromes
- Tension and Migraine headaches

IMIPRAMINE has been used successfully and frequently OFF LABEL by many physicians on multitude of patients for treatment of

- Sleep disturbance
- Nocturnal bedwetting (enuresis)
- Behavioral problems, hyperactivity, school phobia, separation anxiety in children
- Chronic motor tic disorder or Tourette's syndrome
- Depression and anxiety disorder in children younger than 18 years of age

The following RARE but SERIOUS side effects of **IMIPRAMINE** have been reported:

- Sudden drop of blood pressure, or increase in blood pressure, fainting
- Abnormality of heart rhythm, abnormal heart beat
- Myocardial infarction, stroke, seizures
- Abnormality of balance,
- Intestinal paralysis
- Suppression of bone marrow
- Electrolyte abnormalities
- Suicidality
- Mania, Worsening of depression

There are COMMON NON-LIFE THREATENING and REVERSIBLE reactions reported by the **IMIPRAMINE** users such as:

- Dry mouth, nausea, constipation, diarrhea
- Dizziness, blurred vision, sweating (usually in higher doses)
- trembling of hands, tingling in hands (in higher doses)
- Rapid heart beat
- Disorientation and confusion (in higher doses)
- somnolence or insomnia
