***for Treatment with LYRICA***

**LYRICA** is FDA approved for :

- Adjunct treatment of epilepsy
- Diabetic neuropathy
- Post-herpetic neuralgia

**RARE but SERIOUS side effects of LYRICA** have been reported in literature:

- Allergic reactions, severe toxic rash
- Pains in the joints and muscles
- Platelet reduction

**OCCASIONAL NON-LIFE THREATENING** and usually **MILD and REVERSIBLE** reactions reported by the **LYRICA** users such as:

- Somnolence, difficulty with concentration, attention and thinking;
- Dizziness, unsteadiness, fatigue, nausea,
- Dry mouth, blurred vision
- Increased appetite and weight gain
- Peripheral swelling

Combination of LYRICA with alcohol may cause impairment of cognitive and motor functioning (driving a car) and is not recommended.
