NORTRIPTYLINE is an antidepressant medication approved by FDA for the treatment of:

- Depression

NORTRIPTYLINE has been used successfully and frequently OFF LABEL by many physicians on multitude of patients for treatment of

- Tension and Migraine headaches
- Chronic pain syndromes
- Sleep disturbance
- Depression and anxiety, hyperactivity disorder in children younger than 18 years of age

RARE but SERIOUS side effects of **NORTRIPTYLINE** have been reported:

- Sudden drop of blood pressure, or increase in blood pressure, fainting
- Abnormality of heart rhythm, abnormal heart beat
- Myocardial infarction, stroke, seizures
- Abnormality of balance,
- Intestinal paralysis
- Suppression of bone marrow
- Suicidality
- Mania
- Worsening of depression
- Allergic reaction, toxic skin rash

COMMON NON-LIFE THREATENING and REVERSIBLE reactions reported by the **NORTRIPTYLINE** users such as:

- Dry mouth, nausea, constipation, diarrhea
- Dizziness, blurred vision,
- trembling of hands, tingling in hands
- Rapid heart beat
- Disorientation and confusion (in higher doses)
- Insomnia or somnolence
