**INFORMATION regarding THE USE
Of TRILEPTAL**

Indications:

TRILEPTAL is approved by FDA for treatment of :

- Seizures in adults and children older than 4 years of age

TRILEPTAL is used in common medical practice OFF LABEL for:

- Epilepsy in children younger than 4 years of age
- Trigeminal neuralgia,
- chronic pain disorder, peripheral neuropathy
- Migraine prophylaxis

Side Effects:

TRILEPTAL in some instances may cause SERIOUS side effects such as:

- Allergy, severe toxic rash (potentially life-threatening!)
- Bone marrow suppression (low white cell and low platelet counts)
- Low serum sodium concentration

There are COMMON reactions, which are usually reversible or transient, reported by the **TRILEPTAL**' users such as:

- Dizziness, drowsiness, unsteadiness, incoordination
- Nausea, vomiting
- Blurred vision, nystagmus
- Weakness, fatigue
- Elevated liver enzymes
