INFORMATION SHEET
regarding the use of WELLBUTRIN

Indications:

WELLBUTRIN is an atypical antidepressant medication approved by FDA for the treatment of:

- Bipolar disorder, Depression in adults and adolescents
- Tobacco dependency

WELLBUTRIN has been used successfully and frequently OFF LABEL by many physicians on multitude of patients for treatment of

- Depression in children younger than 18 years of age
- Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder in children and adults.

WELLBUTRIN may cause RARE but SERIOUS side effects such as:

- Seizures (at doses exceeding 300 mg/day)
- Irregular heart beat;
- Elevation of blood pressure
- Allergic reaction, including severe toxic skin rash
- Suicidality
- Hallucinations and psychosis,

There are COMMON NON-LIFE THREATENING reactions reported by the **WELLBUTRIN** users such as:

- Dry mouth, nausea, constipation, diarrhea
- Insomnia or somnolence, abnormal dreams,
- fatigue, dizziness, sweating, tremor
